Principal's Report:

P-2 Literacy- 80% are at grade level (overall) 80% of ANS students are at grade level 2 out of 3 Indigenous students are at grade level
3-5 Literacy- 85% are at grade level (overall) 64% of ANS students are at grade level 1 out of 2 Indigenous students are at grade level

SSP- Cycle 2- We are currently in cycle 2 of our SSP. In Literacy we are seeing the benefits of having teachers consistently using UFLI. In Math we are focused on computational fluency and collecting data concerning our progress towards this goal. We discussed the ways in which we prioritize ANS and Indigenous students to receive the available supports for both literacy and math.
