Principal's Report:

African Heritage Month: Events took place schoolwide and in classrooms. Owen Lee performed in the gymnasium, as did Maritime Centre for African Dance. Goatworks held workshops in music classes. Shalyn Williams presented to groups of students. Classroom teachers worked with their students to create bulletin board displays. Each class took time to tour around the school to learn more about various topics.

Makerspace:

Tables arrived today so the room is soon going to be set up to be user friendly.

Classroom Resources: Each classroom teacher was given \$2000 to spend at Tattletales on books, professional resources, etc.

Incident Data: Physical violence/Physical aggression are most frequent, followed by insubordination, disruption to the learning environment and discriminatory behaviour.

- Code of Conduct dictates consequences: in-school suspensions, loss of privileges, coaching to develop new behaviours, out of school suspensions, conference with parent.

-Primary students make up 3 times the incidents.

-29 incidents are reported for males, 5 for females.

SAC Grant: Spent on resources for classrooms.
