- 70 HB pencils (sharpened and labelled with initials)
- 1 pencil box/container for supplies (no higher than 10 cm)
- 1 package White Board markers for use with personal white board (Expo or other good quality brand will last longer)
- 1 white board eraser for use with personal white board (available at dollar stores)
- 1 zippered courier bag (available at dollar stores)
- **For Phys. Ed.** 1 Pair of sneakers with non-marking soles (for indoor use, to be left at school)

- 2 Boxes of tissue
- 1 Water bottle
- 1 USB mouse for use with the Chromebooks (can be found at a dollar store)
- 1 set of personal headphones for use with Chromebooks (available at a dollar store)
