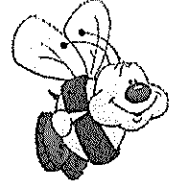

Literacy Goal:

(TO BE REVISED) *To improve student achievement in writing in the areas of organization, language use and conventions:*

- Classroom teachers will use Writer's Workshop with specific instruction and conferencing on all traits of writing, with a focus on organization, language use and conventions.
- Teachers will provide students with clear learning targets, such as "I can..." statements for every writing workshop lesson.
- As a PLC teacher will engage in common scoring of student writing and use the resulting information to monitor students' writing development, make instructional decisions, and provide students with timely feedback. They will also observe one another teaching in their classrooms.

Math Goal:

(TO BE REVISED) *To improve student achievement in the area of number with a focus on conceptual understanding:*

- Classroom teachers will use a constructivist approach to math instruction with an emphasis on productive student talk time and sharing.
- Teachers will provide students with clear learning targets, such as "I can..." statements for every three-part lesson, with a focus on number.
- As a PLC teacher will engage in common scoring of classroom number sense assessments (using HRSB rubrics) and use the resulting information to monitor students' conceptual understanding, make instructional decisions, and provide students with timely feedback. They will also observe one another teaching in their classrooms.
